

Big Auto Trade.

During the year ending June 30, 1914, American manufacturers shipped 28,306 pleasure autos, 784 commercial trucks and a large amount of auto parts to foreign countries. The combined value of these exports was approximately \$43,200,000 according to a report issued by the Department of Commerce. Practically every country on the globe bought American made autos last year. The exports to European countries were 13,357 cars, valued at \$12,250,000; North American countries took 5,488 cars valued at \$10,686,000; Oceania 4,996 autos, worth \$4,485,000. South America, Africa and Asia followed in the order mentioned.

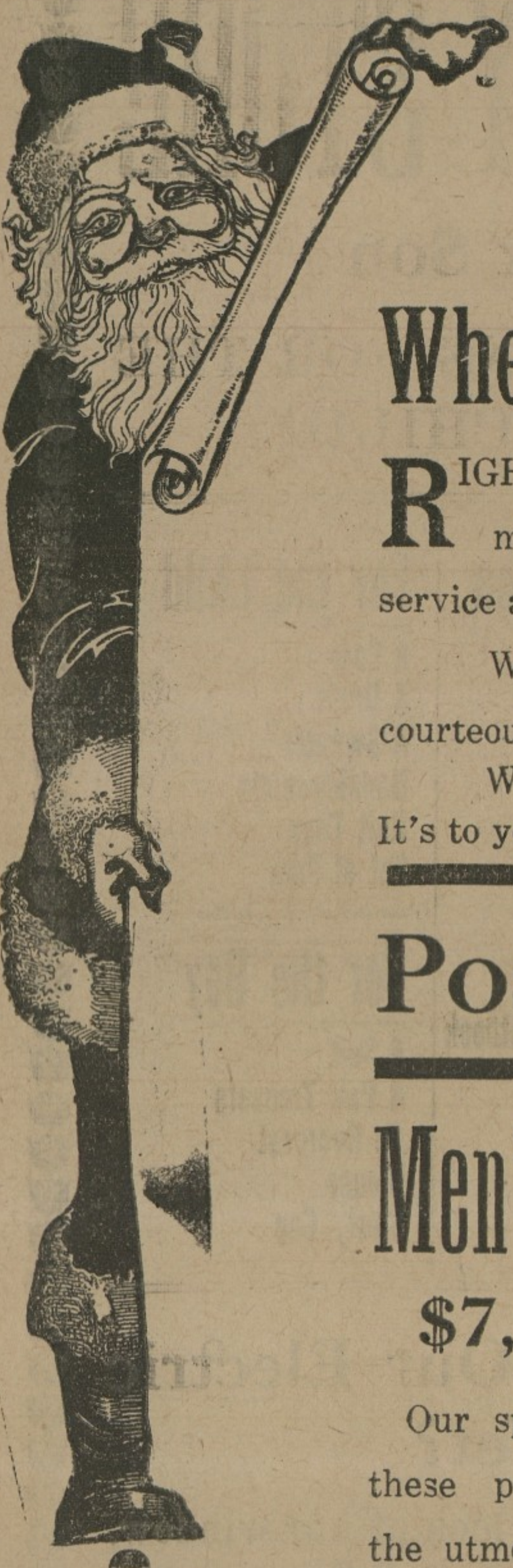
