"Your letter of some time ago received with pleasure, and am sure if every soldier could receive such encouraging letters reassuring him of the folks at home he could not help but be contented and do the best that was possible for him to do. While we know the folks at home are square behind us, yet I know it does me good to read it direct from them. It puts life and ambition into me and makes the hardest things easy.

"I have nothing but praise for Uncle Sam's Army—all that I have seen—and you can rest assured that all is being pushed as fast as possible and still do it right. Our work is important in a way, yet I feel that the boys in the fighting lines are the ones that will bear the battle's front, and they certainly have my respect and confidence. It begins to look like we might go overseas in the near future. Am in hopes I get to see France before I take off my uniform. Tell 'Bird' and Mr. Elburn I will write them in a day or so. Give Mr. Thomas and Mr. Brown my regards; also 'Bosie' if he is not in the army yet.

"I remember Chestertown with pleasure and would not take anything for the ten months I was lucky enough to spend there."

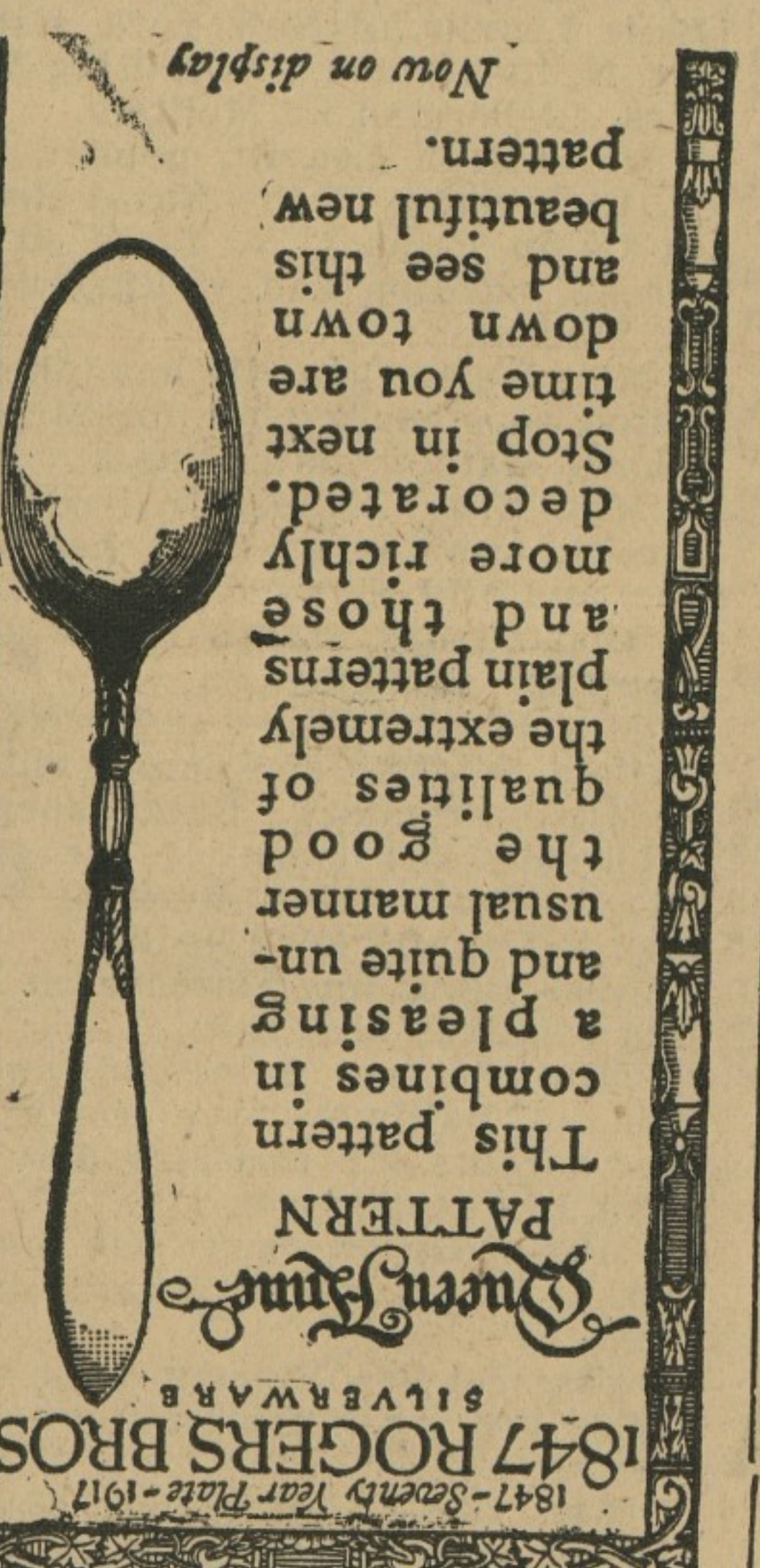
