The monthly meeting of the Home Economics Club was held at the home of Mrs. Ida Storke.

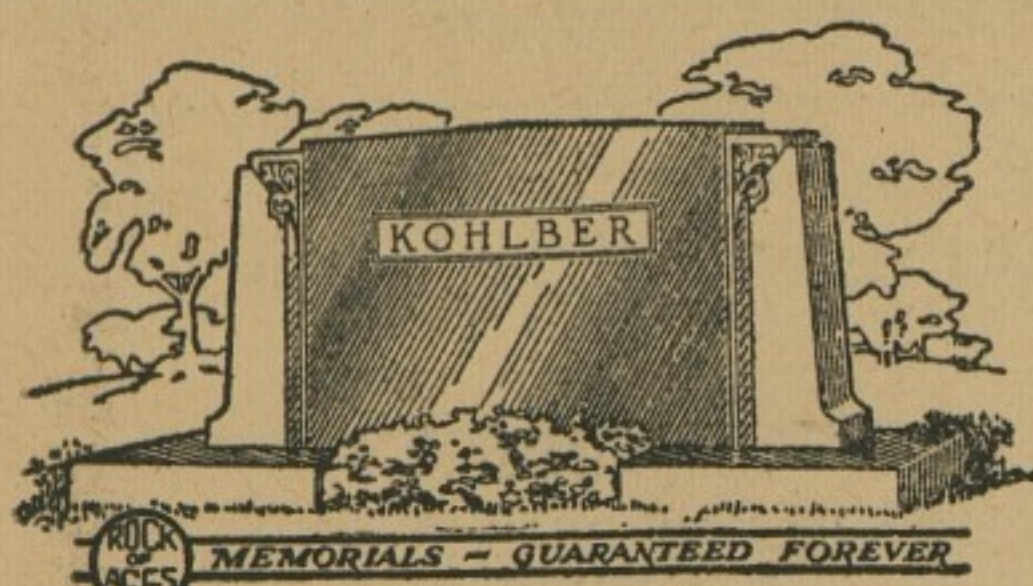
