Should no desire be expressed for a ballot, then the district meetings may select delegates by a viva voce vote.

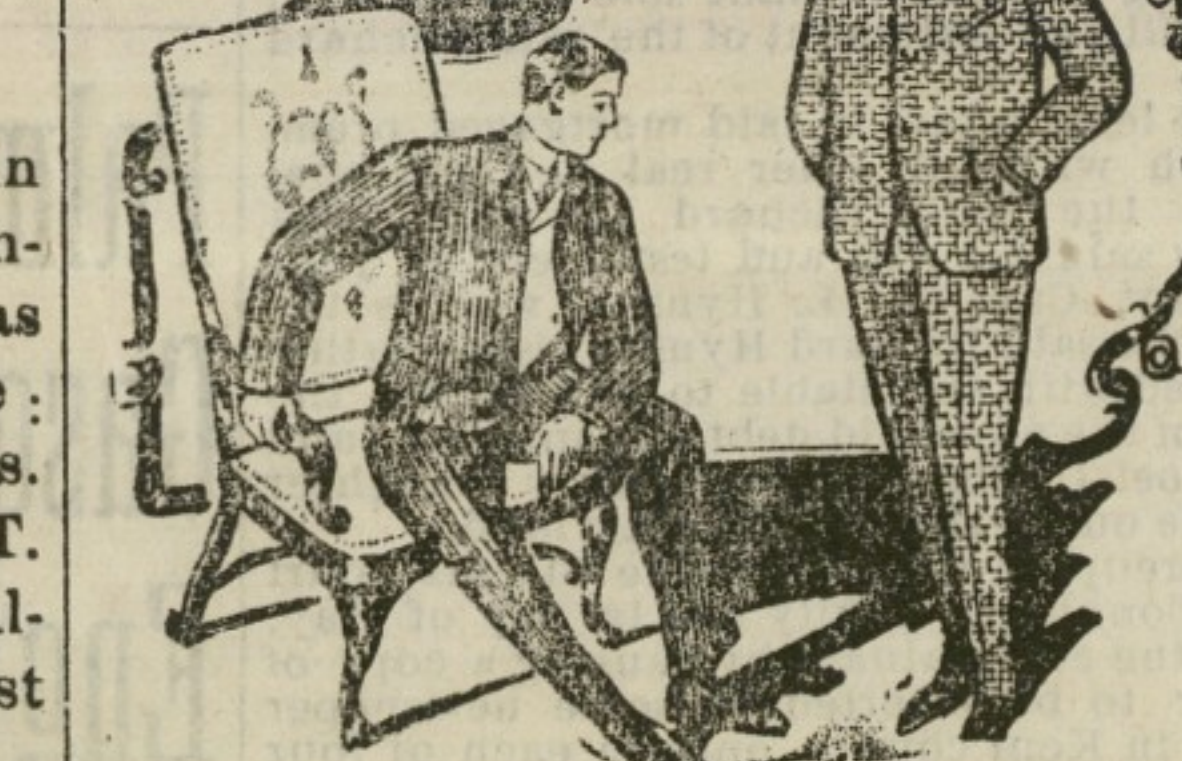

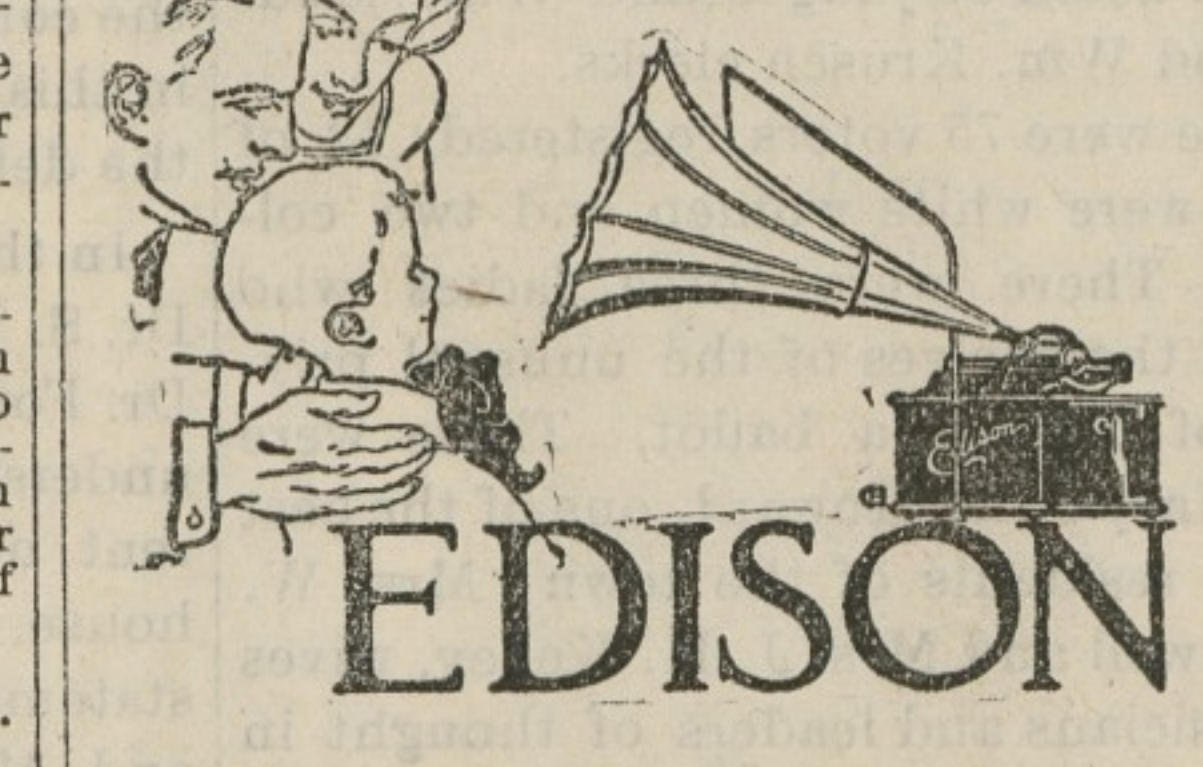
