CHESAPEAKE BRIDGE POSSIBLE

Expert Engineers Will Make a Favorable Report. No doubt now remains that the bridge across the Chesapeake Bay will be built.

If the assurance given the committee of the Merchants and Manufacturers Association are correct, for the report of Westinghouse, Church, Keer & Co., engineers, on the project will be favorable.

At the time the Merchants and Manufacturers Association appropriated \$1,000 to pay for the expense of a preliminary survey for the bridge, Mr. Weatherly assured them that if the firm of Westinghouse, Church & Keer would make a favorable report on the project, he had the promise of a number of capitalists to finance the proposition.

At the conclusion of his survey Mr. Bugler paid a visit to Mr. Boggs, secretary of the Merchants and Manufacturers Association, and acquainted him with the results of his investigation.

Mr. Bugler declared himself delighted with the maps of various sections of Maryland which are procurable, especially those made by the Geological Survey.

These were of great assistance to him in his work, and he found them to be absolutely accurate. He found, however, he says, that the people living in the neighborhood did not know where they were.

Mr. Bugler has taken 100 photographs, which he will submit with his report. There will also be a complete map of the bottom of the Bay between the points where the proposed bridge is to cross.

This is from the west shore to Millers Island, to Kent county.

In his report Mr. Bugler will go even further than simply telling of the general conditions. During the 10 days he was making the survey he made a study of the agriculture conditions on the Eastern Shore, and will tell of the prospects in that part of the state and of the development of business and agriculture which a bridge over the bay will make possible.

Mr. Boggs stated that there is a great deal of enthusiasm among business men for the bridge, if the plan is found to be feasible.

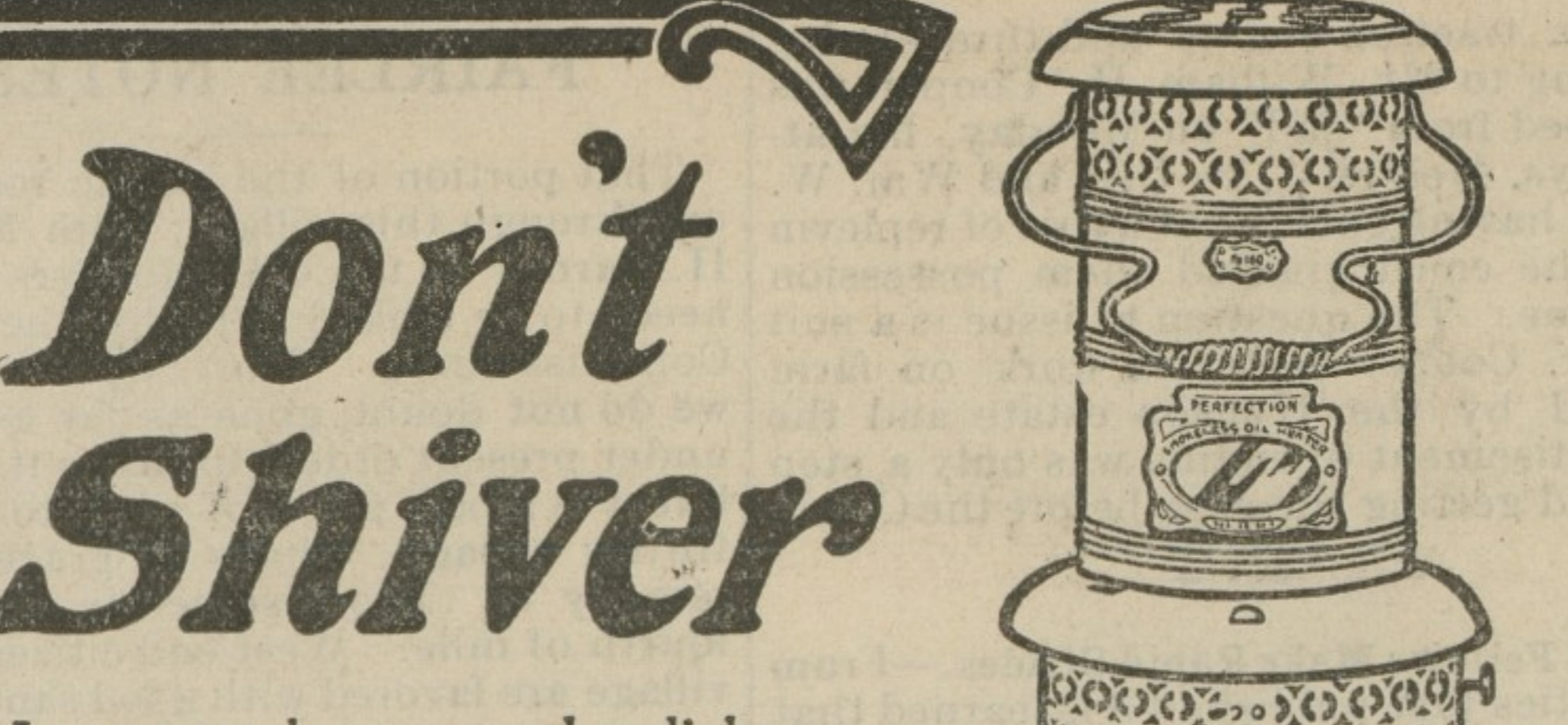

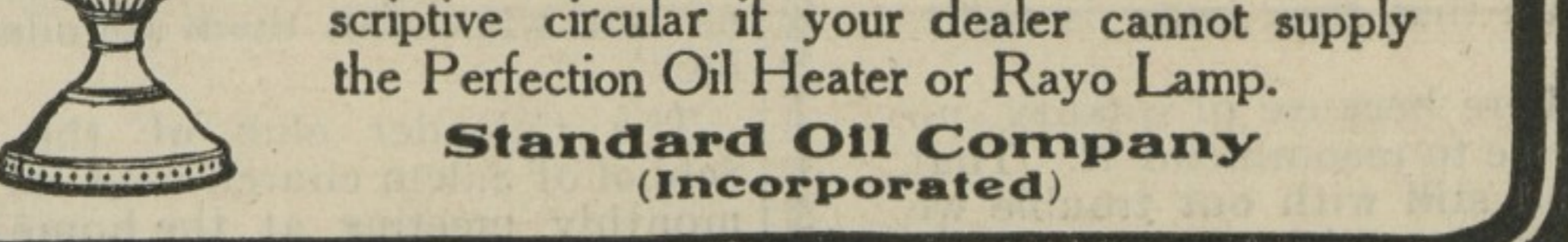
