DUNN CASE REOPENED
In the case of Sanner vs. Dunn, recently tried in the Circuit Court for Talbot Co., a verdict was awarded for the plaintiff for \$2,500. A motion was made to have the verdict set aside and a new trial granted. The Court filed an order with the Clerk Friday to the effect that a new trial be granted unless the plaintiff accepted a remitter of \$1,000 on the verdict. If this is not accepted, a new trial will be granted.

AUTOMOBILE ACCIDENTS
John Quinn and brother, Dan, while going around a curve near Galena met with an auto accident. The wheel came off of the car and upset. John Quinn had his collar bone broken and was taken to Elkton Hospital where he was given attention. He is now getting along very well. His brother was not hurt. Samuel C. Walters and Harry Clark in automobiles were in collision Wednesday night near Galena and both cars very much damaged.

MR. OREM ALQUITTED
Dudley Orem, junior partner of the firm of H. D. Orem & Son, of Chestertown, indicted in Elkton Court for obtaining money and chattels under false pretenses, pleaded not guilty and elected trial by jury. Mr. Warburton for State. Joshua Clayton, Esq., for defense. Ward L. Baker, of near Chesapeake City, bought from Orem & Son a Case tractor, for which Dudley Orem secured his note for \$1250, endorsed by his mother, and another tractor. Mr. Baker claimed that he bargained for a new tractor, and that after using the machine a couple of months he discovered that it was a rebuilt one. The defense claimed and proved that the entire deal had been for a rebuilt machine. The Court returned a verdict of not guilty.

ABERDEEN GUN SHAKES KENT AND QUEEN ANNE'S HOUSES
Under the leadership of W. Irving Walker, a committee of Kent and Queen Anne's county citizens applied to the government last week to stop the firing of a 16 inch gun at Aberdeen, which has caused considerable damage in Chestertown and across the bridge in Queen Anne's. Plaster on the walls have been shaken down by the intense reverberations, electric wires have been broken, and many windows have also been shattered. There seems to be but one particular gun which caused all the damage, and last week, army officials sent officers to Chestertown to investigate the complaints and they were amazed at the vibrations felt in that vicinity. In one instance a baby carriage left standing in front of one of the stores, started moving when this gun was shot, and rolled from the sidewalk into the street and turned over.

FARM BUREAU MEETING
A fine meeting of the Kent County Farm Bureau was held Tuesday in Chestertown. E. Thos. Massey, presiding, with Wm. G. Smyth, secretary. E. P. Cahill, president, and Melvin Stewart, secretary of the State Farm Bureau, were the principal speakers. Several matters of vital importance to the members of the bureau pertaining to co-operative marketing and buying were discussed and plans adopted for the purchase of spring fertilizers and clover seed, etc. It is said that the bureau saved the farmers of this section from \$5 to \$8 a ton on their fall fertilizer and it is believed that equally as much will be saved on spring goods.

About six months later the Department of Agriculture, at Washington, received the following letter from him: "I bane sign up for your farm bureau. Not yet received it. Marm-se have want board at our house and wife wants bureau for spare bedroom. For why you not send it yet? Tell Me."

He received the following letter in reply: "Dear Sir: Yours of 23rd inst. to hand and beg to say, that we have no bureaus in Washington that we can send out at the present time. However, we have an "All Farm Bloc," and as soon as we lay our hands on it, we will have it sawed up, made into a farm bureau and send to you."
