Saturday, January 14, 1978, is the 194th anniversary of the ratification of the Treaty of Paris, which officially ended the War for Independence. This historic event occurred in the State House in Annapolis, where Congress was then sitting.

The Maryland Hall of Records, Department of General Services, has arranged with the National Archives to borrow the original treaty, and it will be featured along with other documents from the Hall of Records in an exhibit in the State House January 14 through January 19. A short ceremony tentatively scheduled for 2:00 p.m. on Ratification Day will be arranged by the Division of Tourism of the Department of Economic and Community Development.
