1. The senate convened 5 November 1792 and adjourned until 12 November when a quorum was present.
2. George Dent had leave of absence on 20 December 1792 and William Perry was appointed President pro tem. On 21 December the President pro tem read a letter from Dent resigning his seat. Perry was then elected President of the senate. John Campbell was elected in his place as senator on 21 December.
3. Charles Carroll of Carrollton was appointed to revise the proceedings at the close of the session.
