~~Senate 1794 November Session~~

1. The senate met on 3 Nov. 1794 and adjourned until 17 Nov. when a quorum was present.
2. William Perry, President, was absent on 17 Nov. 1794 and John E. Howard was elected President. Howard resigned ^{on} 25 Nov. as ^{pres. pro tem.} Perry appeared, ^{when} ~~qualified~~ and took his seat ^{on the} same day.
3. William Tilghman resigned his seat in the Senate on 17 Nov. 1794 in a letter dated Philadelphia, 10 Nov. 1794 stating he had moved from the state.
5. Announcement was made of the death of Brice Thomas Beale Worthington ^{on} 18 Nov. 1794
4. Benjamin Stoddert's ^{letter of} resignation, ^{dated Georgetown,} was received on 19 Nov. 1794.
6. Thomas Sm Lee, William Cook Lee, and Matthew Tilghman were elected ^{on} 21 Nov 1794 to fill the vacancies. Lee declined to serve on 11 Dec. 1794. Richard Sprigg was elected on 17 Dec to his place and appeared ^{on} 18 Dec.

Stoddert had accepted the presidency of the Columbia Bank and his health would not permit him to do both.
