1. John T. Mason was elected to the senate, in place of Samuel Ringgold ~~7 November 1807~~ ^{on November 7, 1807} who declined to serve during the preceding session.
2. James H. McCulloch declined to accept his seat in the senate ^{on} 7 November 7, 1807. Leonard Covington was elected in his place ^{on} 7 November 11.
3. Stephen Lowrey resigned the chair ^{on} 23 November 23 and William Thomas was ^{unanimously} ~~unanimously~~ elected. President of the Senate.
