7 November 1808

Partridge, M' Elderry, and Somervell.

Nov 8, 1808 To inquire what, if any, alterations are necessary in the law to regulate and discipline the militia of this state, and that the committee have right to bring in a bill.  
Covington, M' Elderry, Partridge, Shriver, Gibson.  
Mr. Somervell added 11 Nov. 1808.

Nov 8, 1808. A Committee to bring a bill entitled "An act to abolish all such parts of the constitution and form of government as relate to the time and manner of electing the senate, and the mode of filling up vacancies; also the 23rd section and such parts of the constitution as relate to the amendment of money bills by the senate."
