

Common Senate 1811-1812

1. The senate met 15 June 1812 by a special proclamation of the Governor. In a letter to the Assembly, Gov Bowie tells that the president of the U. S. has required him "to take effectual measures to organize, arm, and equip according to law, and hold in readiness to march at a moment's warning, his proportion of one hundred thousand militia, officers included,..." and Bowie deemed it indispensably necessary to convene the General Assembly "that they may comply with the requisitions."

2. June 17, 1812 the death of Mr Lloyd Dorsey was noted. Mr John Stephens was elected in his place the same day.
