

Senate 1817

(rewrite)

1. The Senate met 1 Dec 1817, but adjourned until 5 December when a quorum was present.

2. The resignation of Mr John Lugh was accepted on 8 Dec. 1817. He did not appear.

The Senate adjourned 20 December 1817 until 29 December but a quorum was not present until 1 Jan 1818.

4. Surname was also spelled Halliday. (10 Feb. 1818)

5. Announcement was made of the death of Archibald Van Horn on 9 December 1817. Edward H. Calvert and Vergil Maxcy were both elected to fill the vacancies.

6. A Letter of resignation was received from Joseph E. Muse on 12 December 1817.

7. Stephen Purnell was elected in place of Muse on 16 December. On 5 January 1818 Purnell declined because "private affairs forbid public life". The letter was dated "Wigman, Worcester, 12 December 1817. William Carmichael was elected in place of Purnell on 6 January 1818.
