

General Assembly 1821

1. Senate met 3 December and adjourned until 4 December when a quorum was present.
2. The President presented a letter from Mr John Strickler who declined to serve in the Senate 4 December 1821. Mr Reverdy Johnson was elected to take his place.
3. John Stepher resigned his place 31 Dec 1821. Dennis Claude elected in his place 7 Jan 1822.
- ¹⁸²⁰ 4. Letter of resignation received from John E. Howard on 6 December. Richard Carroll was elected in his place.
6. Brownley was called Joseph 1 December 1821 and in future lists.
