

## Senate 1822

1. Letter of resignation received from Isaac M'Kim  
8 January 1823 stating that he had been elected  
to fill a vacancy in Congress from the fifth Congressional  
district.

January 10, 1823 General William H Winder was  
elected in place of M'Kim.

2. Dec 13, 1822 leave of absence was granted to M'Kim  
& Wootton. Wootton not present Dec 16. On 21 Dec he  
was not listed as absent. However, Wootton was not  
mentioned again either as appointed to a committee or  
voting.
