

Senate 1824

1. The senate met 6 December and adjourned until Dec 7 when a quorum was present
2. Notice was given of the death of General William H Winder and Col. Athanasius Ferwick, on 9 Dec. 1824. James Thomas was elected in place of Ferwick. John Scott was elected in place of Winder.
3. Notice was made of the resignation of William Price on 9 December 1824. Fusby Fulghman was elected in his place.
4. Mr Johnson was absent because of indisposition until 13 Jan. 1825 and his place filled up on standing committees. He did not subsequently appear.
5. Robert W. Bowie was elected President pro tem on 24 January 1825. Mr Stuart returned Jan 26.

On 26 December 1825 at the beginning of the December session, Johnson was singled out as not having qualified, and subsequently did.
