

Senate 1832

1. a letter of resignation was received from George Reed dated Greensborough Jan 14, 1833 was received and read to the senate on 18 January.
"Owing to severe and protracted indisposition."
John C. Groome of Elkton was elected in his place on February 5, 1833 and his reply accepting election was recorded 13 Feb. 1833.
2. Mr. Hughlett elected President pro tem 6 Feb. 1833 and again on 4 March 1833. until 11 Nov.
