

Senate 1833.

1. The seat of Littleton P. Dennis was declared void, he having been elected a representative to the United States Senate. Henry P. C. Wilson was elected in his place 30 January 1833 and appeared on January 2, 1834.
2. Dennis Claude was elected President pro tem on 17 January 1834. Mr Forest, President returned 28 January.
3. On a motion by Mr Groome, the President appointed a standing committee on Divorces 21 Jan 1834.
