

## Senate 1834

1. B.S. Forrest resigned as president of the Senate in a letter dated Annapolis (City Hotel) 29 Dec. 1834. He stated decline of his health, and the inclement season in which the sessions were held as reason. Mr Sappington was then elected President and served until Jan. 19, 1835 when he resigned as President. Mr Chapman was elected next day. On March 3 Mr Sappington was elected President pro tem. Mr Chapman returned 9 March.
2. Surname was also spelled Osborne on 30 Dec 1834. and elsewhere. Osborn was used in the roll calls.
- 3 - The Senate met 28 Dec 1834 and adjourned until 29 Dec when a quorum was present.
