

Senate 1841

1. Benjamin C. Howard, the senator for Baltimore City having resigned in the recess of the senate, William Frick the senator elected to fill the vacancy thereby occasioned, appeared in the senate chamber, qualified agreeably to the requirements of law and took his seat. 27 Dec. 1841
2. Mr Ely was elected President pro tem 24 Jan. 1842 and served until 27 January.
3. Mr Patte was elected President pro tem 26 Feb 1842 to 28 Feb. and on 9 March 1842 to the end of the session 10 March.
