

Senate 1842

1. Jan 10, 1843 the Senate ordered that the standing rule of the Senate, requiring the annual appointment of a committee on divorces, be rescinded.
2. Mr Thomas' presence required in St Marys for a few days and Mr William T. Goldsborough was elected President pro tem 23 Jan 1843 to 28 Jan 1843
3. A debate was recorded concerning "an act to sell the states interests in the internal improvement companies, and to pay the debts of the state." a division among the senators occasioned both sides registering protests. pg. 239
4. A name index was included in the end of Senate Journal 1842 for years 1837 to 1841 inclusive. The executive proceedings of the Senate ^{were} printed separately at end of volume.
