1. Adjourned until December 2, 1817 when a sufficient number were present. On December 20, 1817 the House adjourned for the holidays. Although it was scheduled to reconvene on December 29, a sufficient number to form a quorum was not present until December 31.
2. The Committee of Elections and Privileges reported the election of Robert I. H. Handy for Worcester County. However, the clerk recorded the attendance of Robert J. H. Handy.
3. The Committee of Elections and Privileges reported the election of Charles S. Sewall. The clerk spelled the name as Sewell within the proceedings.
4. The Council proceedings list the order of its members as Murray, Slope, Howard, Callin and Jones. December 9, 1817.
The Council met December 19, 1817.
