Wth Scot I write these few lines unto you to let you know that I am very uneasy about this land that M^r Medical has taken of me in possession; there is no expectation of him as I do understand of given it up; except it is by the force of law which I am not able to undergo and Medical very well noes that please to let me know by the first opportunity how circumstances is I expect you no best if you can hold it or not; and no the shortest way of getting the land back; and M^r Medical is going to move to Philadelphia in a short time and I expect it is to keep possession of the land which I ought to have the field this summer to tend he has taken in possession eleven acres ⁱⁿ one field measured and three acres of my best meadow ground and two acres of timber land and besides about three acres of your land which is not sold to me
