On the same day came also Honor _____ wife of the said Thomas Durbin and being by us privately examined apart from, and out of the hearing of her said Husband, agreeably to Act of Assembly in such Cases made and provided, she acknowledged, that she did relinquish all her Right, and Title of Dower of, in, and to, the within mentioned Land and Premises, and that she made this her acknowledgment willingly, and freely, without being induced thereto by Fear, or Threats of ill-usage from her said Husband, or fear of his Displeasure.
