

Dear Sir Melvoir June 26th - 1811

²⁶/₁₆ Pompy arrived here to day about 12 o'clock and handed me your letter. agreeable to which I have added the large Cow at \$25 & the Rifer at \$5. to the Cattle you had purchased when here - The balance of \$70 remaining in my favor. forwarded to the care of Dr. Scott. will answer very well - I have had the Cattle 7 head. with the three sheep. put into an enclosure this evening, to be ready for an early start in the morning. I have ordered one of my servants to assist Pompy in driving as far as they can get on tomorrow & hope Pompy will proceed on with proper attention afterwards -

I trust your neighbors will not be unmindful of your wishes

As Pompy tells me his money is most safe. I have left him here \$2 on your acc^t -
