April 26 1814

I received your letter of the  
24<sup>th</sup> and the Bundle I delivered your letter  
to Mr Seantars he said there were 80 in it  
there is a man here who can cure Uptans  
tars several people told me that he  
has cured a great number he told me  
it would not cost me more than 8/6 but  
I would not do any thing until I heard from  
you Mr S, approves of Mr S, says she  
will be much obliged to you for the  
wool and a little Merino mixed with it  
as it is ~~with~~ for stockings Mr Allan says  
his prayers regular he will get a card  
every Saturday which will forward  
every opportunity Mr Mester I gave  
the 9 to Mr Sars as she has a little till  
her to write with In the next time  
she writes Joe was so drunk this mor-  
ning that he could hardly speak,  
The examinations are on Friday we  
will have holiday on Saturday I had  
to get Mr Allan a new spelling Book a  
reading Book We are all well and  
send our love to all the family  
please write as soon as possible concerning
