I sold 4 bags of flour in
W. Minster at \$3.25 which was the highest I could
get & the remainder Jarvis took at the same
except 2 bags which I sold at \$3.50 which were
weighed & came to \$8.53. The Gallow only got
15 cents for bar the common price is 14 then
we only ¹¹² good weight. I have got a load
for Pittsburg at \$5 ¹¹² there are 2241 it is for
Mr Robinson it is to be delivered in 20
Days that is the usual time I send his
account enclosed. The whole flour came to
\$73.46 ¹¹² & the Gallow \$16.80 the waggow had
be mended which cost \$1.50 I will take \$26
18 for Mr Kinose & 5 for Charles & 2 for
myself I am afraid I will not be able to make
out a correct account as I had some money
which I had no account of I send you 63 24
Tell Rose I could not get either the tub or
pail & I have not seen Mr Lee yet as he
is not often in but I expect he will change
it
