or to *his* Assigns, he or they paying freight for the said Goods at the rate of Six Cents
per Bushel
with primage and average accustomed. In Witness whereof the Master or Purser of the said Schooner
hath affirmed to *two* Bills of Lading, all of this tenor and date; one of which being accomplished,
