

Dear Sir, 23<sup>d</sup> Nov<sup>r</sup> 1810

I have just started six hundred  
Large fat Hogs Intended for you by Mr. Propuk  
which I think will average equal to those you  
purchased last winter from me they will be fed  
well & Draw slow, in order to keep them up I did  
not wish to write to you till I could write with  
certainty that these are the largest hogs  
I could get. I expect to be at Baltimore this  
winter with about the same number of hogs  
myself, they will not be so large, a great  
part of the hogs that will come early to market  
this year, will be Drawn from the West I was  
therefore obliged to wait for Corn fed pork  
which I consider at least an Dollar per hundred  
better than the former Mr. Propuk will write to you  
Occasionally, the hogs will I expect be at  
Annapolis
