

the 3,500,000 - The produce is about 3,500,000
 Cans of Oysters packed raw (iced), and some
 2,500,000 hermetically sealed - About 1000

Wheat - The Crop of 1864, though excellent in
 Quality, was short in Quantity, and the stock
 was exhausted almost before the Crop of
 1865 was harvested - The latter was both
 short, and inferior in Quality, and in
 spite of the absence of any foreign demand,
 prices have kept pretty well up.

Corn - The partial failure of the Crop of
 1864, and the heavy Government demand,
 caused very high rates to rule at the
 beginning of the year, but the closing
 of the War, and the favorable prospects
 for the coming Crop, caused prices to
 steadily recede, till the lively demand
 which sprung up for export to Great
 Britain prevented them falling as low as
 otherwise might have done -
