June 10. 1740.

Ordered that the Comm^{rs} of the Paper Currency Office be acquainted to write to the Justices of the sev^l County's (who have now in their hands any part of the sum which the Thirty Shillings amounted unto that was Transmitted to the several County Courts at the first Emission of the Paper Currency to be distributed to each Taxable) to Permit Such Money immediately to the Comm^{rs} at. And it is further Ordered that the Comm^{rs} at. do require the said Justices to send their Reasons in Writing to them Whosoever they retained those Monys so long in their Possession Without their rendering any Account (as the said Justices have done) to the Comm^{rs} at.
