 is guilty of the Felony and Theft above in the Indictment specified in manner
 and form as therein set forth whereupon on the prayer of the said Thomas
 Johnson Junr. who for that Judgment on the Verdict aforesaid be rendered and
 for that the said Negro Coffee does not gain any the same.
 November the 16th 1762 It is therefore Ordered by the Court here That
 the said Negro Coffee by the Sheriff aforesaid be taken from the Bar of
 the Court here and carried to the Prison from whence he came from
 thence to the common place of Execution and there to be Hanged by the
 Neck untill he is Dead

Ordered by the Justices of the Court here that the Clerk signify to his
 Excellency the Governor that they are sorry that they cannot recommend
 to his Mercy Negro Coffee Slave of Mr. Henry Wright Crabb who this Court
 was tried for Felony and found guilty and Sentence of Death passed
 upon him accordingly
