Enclosed is a Transcript of a Record  
you will see that W<sup>m</sup> Carlyle was indebted to  
Geo: Younger the sum of 17:18:8 Sterling, said  
Debt not being paid, Alexander Carlyle of whom  
who is Administrator of the Estate of the said  
was sued for it, and a judgement given against  
said Administrator in this County Court, but reversed in  
Provincial Court. Now my Desire is that you  
make out a Addition to his Decree for a 12<sup>th</sup> Part  
on behalf of the said Younger and send it down by  
this Bearer that the said Alexander Carlyle may be  
before he go out of this Province, he having set up a  
Note of his intended Departure at the  
Secretary's Office and he pleads to  
Chawry against him as soon as is needful  
prove that he had sufficient Notice of the said Debt  
before he had fully administered. I may say it will  
set off for in his Acc<sup>t</sup> in the Comptrolners Office there  
is but one Debt paid that was by Bond. I Pray you  
Particular Care and Dispatch in this Affair on  
a very honest Man will lose a just Debt: your fees and  
the Charges shall be paid by

in your Party and he being a Stranger here, I make bold to request  
you for your advice who is likely to be his Chawry and who he may
