Answer to the best of my remembrance Mr Woomer, Lt
Commissary & Major William Ireland did apply
and I said I had the Records but said Harrison
Refused, Locking the Door which the same was
Lodged and put the key in his pocket & carried
the same home; afterwards the Gentlemen agreed
appointed to meet some days after, and Ordered
their Respondant to acquaint Mr Harrison
thereof & desired him to meet them, or send the
key. This Respondant did acquaint said
Harrison according to Request but he neither
met them nor sent the key as he was desired
