Shrs Honours, I have the honor to receive
the order of the House of Assembly, dated the 4th
inst. in relation to the petition of the
inhabitants of the County of Prince Georges
communicated whereas the Council are desirous
to give them to some select Ldys with whom
they hope they will so far prevail as to incline the
Ldship not to dissent to the bill for regulating
the fees and as your House and this differ
