

A pair of a Letter from Sir R. B. of
 the District of Ga. of New York to
 Sir John Carter Calverly Ga. of the
 Province of April 1721

The enclosed paper, will show you
 both the Cause, and grounds of my
 giving you the trouble. If there is not
 any care taken to repair the fortifications
 on the frontiers of New York and to build
 some new ones. The French will soon have
 it in their power to let the Indians ravage
 all the Colony, where the plantations are
 remote from great Towns. I must therefore
 request it to you to provide the Re-
 fund and supply of money which the King
 has named in the quota of your Province
 and hand it in to New York to be
 applied as the King's Instructions Direct
