 and firmly bound unto Sir William Axtelton of the County of Stafford
 the sum of Five hundred Pound Sterling money of England to be
 paid unto him the said Sir William Axtelton within the six next Court
 signs to the which Payment well and truly to be paid and done we had our
 selves jointly and severally for the whole and in the whole our and Elixer of our
 hojn Executors Administrators jointly of these Provinces as sealed with our
 hands and seals this 15 day of September in the 29 year of the reign of our
 said Majesty Queen Elizabeth first 1705

The condition of this obligation is such that if the above bound Robert
 Howard do make his appearance before her Majesty's Justices of the Peace
 in the County of Stafford at Annapolis in manner the last parting of
 the instant September to answer unto certain writs of capias that he
 send unto him the said Justices of one hundred Pound Sterling
 money of England that then this obligation to be void and of no effect
 otherwise to be and remain in full force and virtue
