in the hands and possession of the said Susanna by finding
came yett the said Susanna knowing the said cattle to be
the proper cattle of the said Anthony and to him of
right to belong ascertained and meaning him the said
Anthony of the said cattle craftily to deceive and defraud
the said cattle to the said Anthony hath not delivered all
to the said Susanna hath been by the said Anthony
then required particularly on the 6th day of June Anno
Dni 1707 at the County aforesaid but the said cattle afterwards
viz the 7th day of June 1707 at the County aforesaid to her own
proper use and profit hath converted and disposed to the
damage of the said Anthony forty pounds therefore
over and above the said cattle &c
