

The separation of the Sternum does require
some skill. - it is separation from the collar
bone.

I knew Dr P. - There was nothing
in these remains which would lead him to
suppose it was but the body of Dr P.
Nothing disjunctive which I should expect to
be in his body.

The points were not separated from the
bosom of Anatomical Dissection - - There was
nothing in the vessels indicating that these
remains had been a subject for dissection - -
If it had been a subject of dissection, I should
have expected to have found some purifying
fluid. -

No doubt that all the five pieces found
belonged to one & the same subject.

Crown Plate gave me a block of Mineral
tuff - perhaps 2 inches long. I carried them to
my house - kept them that night; & the next
day about noon I delivered them to Dr Keap.
