The hair on the back was longer than usual - the front the hair was apparently shaved on the sides. The appearance of the entering wound lead me to think the person was approximately 60 yrs of age. I knew Dr P. for 5 or 6 yrs. & intuitively feeling that this - there were no indication in these remains, what I should have hoped to find in Dr P.

Dr P. was a great & a fast worker. The natural conclusion was due the person who cut up supposed some degree of anatomical skill. The manner in which the sternum - breast bone was removed from the thorax region still - & this was to separate - though somewhat irregularly.

I have seen Physicians put up attempts to separate sternum - good physicians, but not
