

Such Physicians as had been accustomed to
make post mortem examinations —

* My wound — The subject had no suspicion
of it.

There was some indication in the calling
& removal of the internal for the extent
for time which indicated that the body
might have been used for purposes of
disposal.

* I examined the opening between the
6 & 7th ribs. Could perceive nothing when
we made the examination which would
show that the stab was made while
the person was alive. The skin &
muscles were then very soft — for
had been there — Dr. Joy will probably
testify how that was done —

We did examine to see if there was
any cut of the rib & found none —

Dr. — I mean that there was no mark
there apparently of any knife — the opening
was very irregular. —

One or two of the ribs were
broken. 3.
