

The charge made by Gov^t as the
 manner in which it is to be proved.

Gov^t must prove - the death of Dr P. -
 that it was caused by Dr M. by violence
 - in the manner set forth in Form One, &
 none of the counts - as well as the offence

The burden of proof is on the Gov^t to establish
 by suff^t proof all the essential elements of
 the crime charged upon the prisoner.

The presumption of Law is, until the opposite
 fact is established that Dr P. is deceased - &
 in other words that the charge of suicide
 has not been proved.

The Gov^t bears the burden, & cannot, procure or direct
 witnesses in support of, or to establish, any one of the
 facts which they are bound to prove; there is
 no direct evidence of the death of Dr P. & that
