

found - (if any) in his statements - on the former
 or in any former occasion

3. The contradiction between his ~~and~~ other
 witnesses - or the incompatibility of their
 respective statements.

4. A separate and distinct examination of the
 testimony of D - the intrinsic evidence which
 it contains of truth or falsehood - as
 the result which upon the whole is to be
 derived from it - This of course being
 taken in connection with collateral &
 independent proofs bearing upon it.

5. So far as all the other evidence in the
 case bears upon the question of the guilt or
 innocence of the Def., it was involved in the
 particular investigation of the testimony of D,
 it may be considered to determine whether
 it corroborates or disbelieves it.
