The proceedings on all of these streets, preliminary and otherwise were published in two daily newspapers, one of which was printed in the German language. We give below a statement of the different streets and their condition:

Lombard street from Garrison lane to Catherine street, advertised first meeting in News and Journal, advertised for paving in Sun and Correspondent.

Lombard street from Catherine to Wilkens streets, first meeting in Sun and Journal, paving in same.

Millington avenue, from Frederick to Wilkens avenues, first meeting in American and Correspondent, paving in same, first return also in same papers.

Carroll street from Caton avenue to Eighth street, first meeting in Sun and Correspondent, paving in American and Correspondent.

Pratt street from Garrison Lane to Catherine street, first meeting in News and Journal.

Catherine street from Lombard street to Frederick Avenue, first meeting in American and Correspondent; paving in Sun and Journal; first return in American and Correspondent; Register's Notice in Sun and Correspondent.

Seventh street, from North Avenue to Northwest street (Westwood avenue) first meeting in American and Journal, paving in American and Journal.

Robert avenue from Whitelock street to Druid Hill Park, first meeting in Sun and Journal.

Massachusetts avenue from Augusta avenue to Loudon avenue, first meeting in Sun and Correspondent; paving in American and Correspondent and first return in Sun and Journal.

McHenry street from Garrison Lane to Catherine street, first meeting in American and Correspondent; paving in News and Journal; first return in Sun and Journal and Register's Notice in Sun and Correspondent.
