1906. That appropriation is limited by its terms to the cost and expenses of the acquisition of a lot, or lot and building, for a parental school in the vicinity of Schools No. 66 and 67 on the Old Frederick Road. The arrangements made by the School Board in anticipation of the use of the lot, or the lot and building, contemplated by the ordinance, sustain in my judgment too remote a relation to the appropriation made by the ordinance to fall within its objects.
