Referring to your letter of the 10th inst. No. 663, I beg leave to say that the opinion referred to was a verbal opinion rendered by me to Dr. Remsen of the Sewerage Commission, to the effect that house drainage cannot be lawfully conducted by any agency of the new sewerage system, whether sewer, drain or pipe, created or adopted by the Sewerage Commission, into Gwynne's Falls, because Gwynne's Falls is a tributary of the Chesapeake Bay, and the introduction of sewage into the Chesapeake Bay, or any of its tributaries, from the City of Baltimore is prohibited by the express terms of the Sewerage Commission Enabling Act.
