 of my real Estate called Mitchels Chance together with my Negro slave
 Isaac. Also I give and bequeath unto my Daughter Mary my Negro
 Slave Harry. Also all the Remainder of my personal Estate after
 paying all my just and Lawfull Debts and above Legacies I give &
 bequeath unto my three Children Ebenezer, ~~Robert~~^{Thomas}, and Mary, to be
 Equally divided amongst them, And I do hereby nominate & appoint
 my loving wife Elizabeth Executrix of this my last Will & Testament
 hereby revoking all former Will & Wills by me heretofore made, In
 Witness whereof I have herewith set my hand & Seal this 15th day of February
 In the year of our Lord 1783.

 Witnesses to the within last Will & Testament of Thomas Sanders late of Kent
 County deceased, and severally made oath on the Holy Evangelists of Almighty God
 that they did see the Testator therein named sign & seal this Will, and that they
 heard him publish pronounce & declare the same to be his last Will & Testam^t.
 that at the time of his so doing, he was, to the best of their apprehensions, of
 sound & disposing mind Memory & understanding, and that they their deponents
 together with John Hurst the other subscribing Witnesses to this Will respectively
 subscribed their names as Witnesses to this Will, in the presence, and at the
 request of the Testator, and in the presence of each other.
