

I give and bequeath to my beloved Wife all my Personal Estate to have and enjoy the same until my son arrives at the age of twenty one years; and then I give all my Personal Estate to my son except one third part thereof which I give to my wife. But if my son should die before he arrives at the age of twenty one year or without lawfull Issue then I give and bequeath all my Personal Estate to my wife. My Will further is and I hereby give a Manumission and freedom to all my Negroes, who shall be of the age of thirty years at the end and Expiration of three years after my decease. and my will is that after the Expiration of the said three years, all and each of my Negroes shall be entitled, to his her and their freedom and Liberty, as soon as he her or they shall arrive at the age of thirty years respectively. It is my further Will and desire, that as soon as my son shall have arrived at a sufficient age and shall have received a Necessary education, that he shall be placed under the care of Doct: James Anderson to be by him educated and brought up to the Study of and Science of Physic. And lastly I hereby appoint my Brother James Trisby, and my Brother in Law Thomas Jarvis James Executors of this my last Will and Testament; hereby revoking all former or other Wills by me made.
