

I John Crockett of Kent County in the State of Maryland do make and ordain this my testament and last Will in manner and form following.

First I order and direct that my Just Debts and funeral expences be satisfied as soon as convenient after my death. Item I give and bequeath to my dearly beloved Wife Mary in fee Simple one clear moiety or half part of all my Estate both real and personal. Item I give and bequeath to my Son Richard in fee Simple the other moiety or half part of my said Estate both real and personal on his attaining to the age of twenty one years; But should it so happen that my said Son should die before he arrives to the Age of twenty one, I then give and bequeath the Share or half part devised to him to my dear Wife Mary in fee Simple this devise to extend to both the real and personal Estate given to my Son Richard.

And lastly I constitute and appoint my dearly beloved Wife Mary whole and Sole Executrix of this my last Will, formally revoking all Wills heretofore made and declaring this and none other as and for my last Will and Testament. In testimony whereof I have hereunto set my hand and Seal the twenty sixth Day of October 1709.
