In the Name of God Amen I Thomas Browning of Kent County and State of Maryland being sick and a low state of body but of Sound mind and Memory and that is appointed for all Men once to Die and as it hath pleased God to bless me with some worldly Goods I do make this my last will and testament in manner and form following First my will is that my brother George Browning shall purchase a Lot of Ground at the Roads near George town and build a house on the said Lot 18 feet by 10 and finish of in a workman like manner with the money due me from my Brother John White Browning and when finished my will is that my sister Cornelia Mitchel shall Posses the same during her widowhood and at her marriage or Death to fall to her Daughter Cornelia Mitchel and her heirs and in case she should Die without her to fall to her sister Sarah Mitchel and her heirs and in case she should Die without her to my Brother George Browning and his heirs, and I do hereby appoint my Brother George Browning <sup>my</sup> whole Executor of this my last will and testament revoking all other will by me acknowledged this to be my last will and testament my hand and Seal this 9<sup>th</sup> of April 1790
